DIRECTIONS FOR USE

MARITIME® dilutes in water and is suitable for use in liquid foliar, soil-applied, and irrigation water applications, including Calcium Ammonium Nitrate and Calcium Thiosulfate solutions. Apply at a rate of 2.0 to 10.0L/Ha.

FOLIAR APPLICATIONS

Fill half the spray tank with water, begin agitating and add recommended amount of MARITIME with remainder of water and spray solution. A minimum spray volume of 140 L/Ha is recommended.

SOIL APPLICATIONS

Soil-applied treatments can be made by mixing with soil-applied nutritional products, through directed sprays to the soil, side dress treatments, applications through the irrigation systems or any other methods which effectively apply MARITIME to the soil. MARITIME can be applied through drip, microjet, sprinkle, overhead, in-furrow, flood and other types of irrigation at the suggested rates.
